

T.K. Watkins Memorial Scholarship

Mr. T.K. Watkins, father of Mike Watkins, was a lifelong farmer. He used Charolais bulls as herd sires for his commercial cattle operation for many years. Mr. Watkins greatly enjoyed being around the Tennessee Charolais Association breeders. In his memory, a \$1,000 annual scholarship will be awarded each year in March at the Tennessee Beef Agribition. **This year 2 scholarships will be awarded.** Each applicant must complete an application and provide the required documents in order to be eligible to receive scholarship funds. A committee from the Tennessee Charolais Association and the Watkins family will determine the recipient based on scholarship record, leadership, and interest in the cattle industry.

1. Applicants must be a current member of the Tennessee Junior Charolais Association (TJCA) in his/her senior year of high school or a current college student at an accredited college or university.
2. If applicant is a current college student, he/she must provide proof of enrollment in a minimum of 12 semester hours in the fall. If applicant is a current high school senior, he/she must provide a letter of intent to enroll in a minimum of 12 semester hours in the fall after graduation. (Funds will not be issued until the student provides documentation from the college or university at the beginning of the fall semester.)
3. Students must have at least a cumulative 2.8 grade point average. An official copy of high school or college transcript must be provided.
4. Scholarship funds are only available for students in an undergraduate program.
5. **All entries MUST be postmarked by FEBRUARY 19, 2017.**
